A call for entry for local artists to celebrate and commemorate Canada’s 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary

June 16 – August 5, 2017

Kitimat is multi-ethnic, representative of many communities across Canada. This is an opportunity for local artists to express their views and impressions on their community and country through the visual arts media. Artists will create their own Kitimat “landscapes” to express feelings for their country, Canada. The “landscapes” could be traditional, or non-traditional such as mountains, rivers, and ocean and feature local flora or fauna, dreamscapes, or urban landscapes (interior and exterior). Artists are welcome to include a written statement or quote to accompany their art work. These pieces may be for sale if the artist wishes.

### **The Artist's Responsibility**

- ❖ Artwork must be received at the Kitimat Museum & Archives by June 9, for installation.
- ❖ Provide all the necessary information on the submitted work requested in the Call for Entry and Entry Forms.
- ❖ Ensure that work is completely ready to hang or install. Any mounts or exhibition furniture necessary should also be provided.
- ❖ The Kitimat Museum & Archives will not charge commissions on any sales, however a donation of 20% of any sales is strongly recommended, so please price your items accordingly.

### **The Organizer's Responsibility**

- ❖ Provision of all information necessary such as dates of installation and removal, reception details, required format for labels.
- ❖ Professional unpacking and re-packing of the works shipped in their original containers. Packing materials will not be kept at the Museum unless the item was shipped.
- ❖ Protection of the artist's copyright on all submitted works. Any use of copyright material must be specifically cleared in advance with the artist, in writing. The terms of affiliation of an artist with a Copyright Society must be respected.
- ❖ Payment to the artist of all monies owing on sales within 30 days of the date of sale.
- ❖ Creation of all posters, invitations and Public Service Announcements, labels and descriptive text.
